**Chick-fil-a Friday Family Fun Day** is designed for parents to tag along with their camper for the morning. They will get to go to the different stations and see what their child has been doing and learning all week. Lunch is provided for free on Friday, you only need to RSVP.

**Alpine! Ocean! Safari!** - Students are divided up by age when they get to camp.  
1st and 2nd are Ocean (Blue) 3rd and 4th are Alpine (Green) 5 and 6th are Safari (Orange)  
They will be encouraged to come dressed in their teams colors each day. It's not required, but encouraged. These colored shirts with the connected logo will be one of the things on sale in the camp store.
