What is The MIX?

The Mix is an in-town retreat that will take place on February 28 March 1, 2020. Students will spend the night in a host home in the Oglethorpe or Athens area (boys separated from girls) with Small Group Leaders assigned to each group. We will attend worship gatherings at the Classic Center on Friday Night, Saturday Morning, and Saturday Night.

When do I register?

Now. The cost for The Mix is **\$40** before January 22nd. After January 22nd, the price goes up to **\$50**. Turn in your form & money to Brody. Invite a friend!

When does the weekend start and where?

Students will need to meet at Salem Baptist Church at **5:30pm** on Friday, Feb. 28th to get started. We will drop luggage in the A.R.C. and load up in the church vans and other vehicles to drive to Athens for the opening session at The Classic Center. We ask that students not drive to and from the Classic Center so that we can better account for everyone that is going. If your student has other commitments that means they'll need to leave during the weekend, please let Brody know.

What time will the weekend conclude?

The Mix 2020 will conclude after the Worship Service at Salem on Sunday, March 1st. You can pick up your student afterwards, or please join us during the service that starts at 11am. We'll spend part of the service recounting what all has happened during the weekend.

How do I get in contact with my student in case of an emergency?

Where will my student be staying?

Host Homes throughout Oglethorpe and Athens. We are still nailing down the details of what homes and where, but we do know that girls will be separated from the guys. Depending on the sleeping arrangement, some students might be on air mattresses while other students might end up in beds. Please plan accordingly.

What projects will my student be doing?

In the past, we've focused on widows in the community who have needed some help around the house or work done. Our plan is to do the same this year.

What does the cost include?

The cost includes a t-shirt, meals on Saturday (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner) and Sunday (Breakfast), Curriculum, Transportation, and entrance into the event.

Why The Mix?

Planned by local youth pastors, this is the 11th year of The Mix. We've had upwards of 35 churches gathered together, all in the Athens area, worshiping together, praying together, and learning from God's Word together. These churches come from all different denominations and has been an incredible display of youth ministries and churches coming together under the banner of making Jesus known.
